- 2) Full Cavaliers of Orders of Glory and Labour Glory for service to Motherland of three classes;
- 3) Participants of the Great Patriotic war;
- 4) Persons honored with medals For Defense of Leningrad and Resident of Blockaded Leningrad;
- 5) Former underage prisoners of concentration camps, ghettos, and other custody places established by fascists and their allies during Second World War;
- 6) Visitors honored with Honored Railwayman and Honored Worker of the October Railway ranks;
- 7) Disabled persons of I and II groups including those in wheelchairs;
- 8) Companion of disabled visitors of I and II groups;
- 9) Companion of visitors with disabilities;
- 10) No more than 2 persons in organized groups – companions of the group of children pre-18 years old (school teacher; leader of the children's workshop or studio; representative of the parents' committee);
- 11) Companion of the organized group of foreign tourists students and cadets (group leader; guide-interpreter; teacher);
- 12)) Veterans of military conflicts, persons impacted by the radiation during Chernobyl plant disaster and Semipalatinsk nuclear weapon tests and persons with equal status;
